Cabinet Report 2025-2026 Qtr 2

The report for District 24L, Second Vice District Governor for 2025-2026 Quarter 2 (**October to December 2025**) is reflected below.

SVDG was assigned **26 Clubs** for District Visits. Clubs Visited: 20; Club (1) Scheduled for January 5: Staunton; Club (2) requested a reschedule date: Westmoreland and Craigsville; Clubs (3) not meeting: Arlington Northwest, Lake Jackson MidCounty; and Virginia Gateway (not responding to outreach - email, phone, card).

In addition to Club Visits, SVDG attended during this quarter Zone N meeting, Monterey Charter Night with 2 Melvin Jones, and held new member orientation and initiated a new member for Fairfax Host.

SVDG attended and successfully completed six sessions for the 2025-2026 Second Vice District Governor Virtual Seminar. The Seminar focused on membership growth, strengthening and developing Clubs; and working towards the District 24L action plan.

SVDG as a member of Fairfax Host supported the Club's Fairfax Fall Festival, fundraising (Fruit Sales), and was committee chair for the purchase and distribution of Thanksgiving and Christmas food baskets for 30 families at the Main Street Development Center in Fairfax, Va.

SVDG addressed the 7 Key Areas as outlined by the District Governor: Lions Global Impact; 24L Theme of Navigating to the Future; Membership Growth with Purpose; Service; Leadership; Upcoming Highlights; and Communication.

Club visit reports have been individually submitted.

Overall, the high performing clubs have continued to engage in fellowship opportunities; clear strategy for the Club; recruiting members to include younger members and low attrition rates; developing future leaders; orientation and mentorship programs; leveraging technology for membership and community engagement; being involved in District wide activities; and developing community wide partnerships. Clubs that are at risk are shown to have small and decreasing membership; leadership is one level deep (limited / no succession); operating in isolation; lack of momentum to recruit; and limited use of technology for outreach.

SVDG was Co-Chair for the Winter Conference to be held on January 10, 2026 at the Winchester Moose Lodge. A separate report will be provided for the Winter Conference.
