SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS:

**Alexandria Asian American Lions Club (AAALC)** extended financial assistance to House of Hope in Davao, Philippines, providing temporary shelter and basic support to children undergoing cancer treatment and their families.

Following a Childhood Cancer Awareness presentation to the **Woodbridge Lions Club**, the club was inspired to extend support to the Fairy Godmother Project, assisting children battling cancer and their families with essential needs and emotional support.

**AAALC** received approval for a \$1000 District Community Impact grant from LCI to support a joint event with the **Filipino American Cancer Cares (FACC)** organization. The event will be a fashion show and concert organized by FACC and held in Spring 2026. The grant will provide critical support to one family in Northern Virginia with a child diagnosed with cancer.

These service efforts reflect the Lions' continued commitment to Childhood Cancer advocacy by expanding awareness, strengthening partnerships, and providing meaningful assistance to children and families in need.
