Guided by our faith in God and love of our community, CCAP is committed to helping our neighbors to meet basic needs with food, clothing, and financial resources.


The Unique Boutique


If a family needs clothes, they can come to the clothing house.

We provide clothing for all sizes, diapers, towels and linens.

We even have shoes and accessories.

In 2025 1562 families utilized the Clothing program.





If a family is hungry and cannot afford to buy food, they can access our food pantry. Winchester City experiences 19% food insecurity.

IN 2025 CCAP SERVED 2896 FAMILIES IN THE FOOD PANTRIES. 8900 PEOPLE FORMED THOSE FAMILIES



Financial aid

CCAP wants to make sure families can stay warm and housed. CCAP helps with paying utilities, rent/mortgage, and heating fuel. CCAP can help with up to \$200 in financial aid per household per year. CCAP provided help for 991 families in 2025.

Hunger Facts

- The 6th congressional district has the second highest food insecurity rate in VA after Southwest VA
- Winchester City has a 19% food insecurity rate
- According to The Blue Ridge Area Food Bank need for food pantry services has increased 15% every year since 2020
