

CANCER CARE

- Help with cancer-related expenses
 - Eligibility:
 - have a diagnosis of cancer confirmed by an oncology health care provider
 - be in active treatment for your cancer
 - live in the U.S. or Puerto Rico
 - meet our eligibility guidelines based on the Federal Poverty Limit
 - Call 800-813-HOPE (4673) and speak with a CancerCare social worker to apply

- Emergency Assistance Fund - \$300
 - Eligibility:
 - child must be inpatient or away from their home for 15 consecutive days within past 90

 - 1 request per 12 months
 - 3 request limit for child's lifetime

SPECIAL LOVE



- Emergency Financial Relief
 - Eligibility:
 - DC, Maryland, Virginia or West Virginia
 - Pediatric cancer patient under 25 years of age
 - participated in 1+ Special Love camps/family programs OR 3+ virtual programs - annual limit of \$2,000
 - non-participants of Special Love one-time assistance of up to \$500
- Scholarships for patients and siblings
