Only one zone N meeting was held by this Zone Chair as I stepped in mid-year to complete this assignment.

Meeting was held in April with only two clubs reporting, Staunton and Waynesboro. Membership in Staunton Lions Club has remained steady this year, no gains, no losses. Waynesboro has acquired two new members as was reported in April. Fundraisers are ongoing and include broom and mint sales (Staunton) and shrimp fest, chicken BBQ, broom sales (Waynesboro). Augusta Club although not present maintains their candy/nut sales, golf tournament, classic car show, and broom sales. All three clubs participate in eyeglass collection/recycling, broom sales, and LOV raffle ticket sales. Augusta Club does vision testing with school children. We have been invited back next year to continue this service. Monterey Club although not present held their pork rind sales at the annual Maple Festival back in March.
