- Food drive - We collected 2,225 pounds of food and \$775 in cash and food gift cards. This was being shared between four local food banks.
- Sponsored a table (\$400) for Beacon for English Language & Literacy at their annual Scrabble Scramble fundraiser.

May

- Surprises for Our Sailors – members donated \$850 worth of toiletries, etc. for sailors on the aircraft carrier, USS George H.W Bush CVN 77.
- Conducted new member orientation for one member with their sponsor. Another is scheduled in June for five new members.

Weekly:

- One of our members collects end of day bread products from Panera and delivers to ACTS, average of 200# weekly.

Monthly

- Bingo twice each month at Birmingham Green (2 locations) serving 35 residents with donated prizes
- Eyeglass recycling monthly with 2-4 members participating
- Assistance with eye exams & glasses for 3-5 adults & children

- Their Bingo fundraising continues to be held every Monday

- Red Robin Fundraiser slated for 5/27/26.

Woodbridge Lions Club:

- Adopt-a-Spot trash pickup done at area surrounding Westridge E.S. by 4 club members
- Presented \$25 Appreciation Gift Cards to 21 Staff members and maintenance crew at Four Season Historic Virginia
- When Target lost power in one of their commercial freezers, they contacted our Club to help with distribution of meat to area food pantries. Club members picked up and delivered over 800 lbs. of meat valued at approx. \$25,000 to Our Lady of Angels Church Food Pantry in Woodbridge.
- The 3rd Tuesday of every month, approx. 10 club members help with Eyeglass Recycling at Park West Lions Club
- Every Tuesday Club members pick up donated food from Olive Garden, WAWA and Food Lion and deliver it to the ACTS Hunger Prevention Center in Dumfries
- On a monthly basis Club members purchase assorted snacks for families living at the ACTS Beverly Warren House in Dumfries.
- Delivered donated items to the First Care Women's Health Center in Manassas
- Our plastic film recycling project continues. A delivery of 127.3 lbs. of plastic film was delivered to Forest Park H. S. in Manassas. A TREX bench is earned for every 1,000 lbs. of recycled plastic. 3 benches have been earned so far.
- Appreciation plaques were presented to our partners at the Rose Gaming Resort and Texas Roadhouse
- Four Club members participated in the Foundation Fighting Blindness walk around Four Seasons neighborhood.
- Over the Memorial Day Weekend, our partners at JC Penney at Potomac Mills Mall allowed us to set up a table in the store to promote Lions and to sell the 2026 White House Christmas Ornaments.
- On June 6/7, Club members will be setting up a booth at the Occoquan Day Craft Fair to sell White House Ornaments.
