The report for District 24L, First Vice District Governor for 2026-2027 Quarter 1 (**July 1 to September 12 2026**) is reflected below.

FVDG was assigned **26 Clubs** for District Visits. **Clubs Visited:**
10. In addition to Club Visits, FVDG partnered with MD24 Disaster Preparedness for District 24L; presented Disaster Preparedness at Club meetings; attended District Visitation; Council of Governor meeting; provided Club membership induction; Club installation of officers; and was active in Fairfax Host fundraising and meetings.

Disaster Preparedness: District 24L coordinated with Districts 24C and 24I to utilize LCIF grant funds for the order of disaster preparedness kits. Note: Due to a change in representation at Church Worldwide Services (CWS), District 24L experienced a delay in receiving the preparedness kits and will plan for distribution at the Winter Conference to be held on January 30 2027. Kits will be ordered, assembled, and stored for future availability.

Fall Conference: FVDG is scheduled to present Disaster Preparedness at the Fall Conference on September 19.

Fairfax Host Lions Club: FVDG as a member of Fairfax Host continued to support various activities to include coordinating with the City of Fairfax for the July 4th (last minute cancellation by City of Fairfax due to heat) and preparations for the Fall Festival and fruit sale fundraising events; and delivery of food baskets for Fairfax Main Street Development Center.

SVDG continued to address the Key Areas as outlined by LCIF and the District Governor: Meaningful Service; Invite New Members for membership growth 1.5; Advocate for Others and develop future leaders; and support LCIF for grants and resources; District 24L Theme of Dare To...; Membership Growth with impact; Partnerships in Service; Leadership; Upcoming Highlights; and Communication.

High performing clubs continue to succeed through meaningful service, strong fellowship, active recruitment and retention, leadership development, mentoring, succession planning, technology, district engagement, and community partnerships
